

COVID-19 Protocols

- Golfers must have a pre-booked tee time to enter the golf course property. Walk-ups are not permitted.
- Tee time capacity has been reduced and tee times have been appropriately spaced to control the number of golfers.
- Only one golfer is permitted into the golf shop at a time. Cash payments are not permitted.
- Practice putting and chipping areas are closed.
- · Golf club rentals and pull cart rentals are not available, please bring your own.
- · On course water drinking fountains are closed (turned off). Please bring your own bottled water.
- Please arrive at the course no earlier than 20 minutes before your tee time to practice 'social distancing'.
- Cash transactions are not permitted anywhere on property.
- When on the golf course:
 - Flag sticks are not to be touched at any time.
 - Raised cups, PVC or other cup fillers will keep the ball from going to the bottom of the hole. We encourage continuous putting and 2' gimmies to all golfers.
 - Ball washers have been removed (please bring your own damp towel).
 - Rakes have been removed (a local rule is in place to allow you to 'foot rake' the bunker and place the ball in a better lie).
 - Sand/ seed bottles have been removed.
 - Shoe blowers have been removed.
 - Pull carts are available and sanitized after every round.
 - Rental Clubs are not available. Please bring your own clubs.
 - Practicing physical distancing while walking down the fairway, while searching for lost balls and on the greens is mandatory.
- Where golf carts are available:
 - Power cart usage is limited to a single rider only (unless with a family member of the same physical address).
 - Power carts are cleaned and disinfected before and after each round.
- Where a driving range is available:
 - The number of stalls have been reduced to allow for physical distancing.

- Please bring your own bucket for receiving range balls.
- · Range balls are sanitized daily.
- We are monitoring all golfers to ensure social distancing of 2 metres (6 feet) occurs at all times.
 Failure to comply may result in your removal from the golf course.
- · No loitering or socializing anywhere on the property, before or after your round.

Other considerations:

The washroom situation will be different at each facility.

- The on-course washrooms are closed, washroom facilities at the clubhouses (vary by facility) but are regularly sanitized.
- The clubhouse is closed. On-course washrooms are open. Staff are disinfecting the "touch surfaces" once per hour and those using the facilities are asked to use the available disinfection materials to wipe down the sink handles and door handles after use. A waste paper bin is located outside the door to deposit your paper towel.
- Do not touch your playing partners or their equipment, meaning no high five's, fist bumps or hand shakes.
- · Courses will not "pair up" groups for play
- Please read an obey all signage when at the course.
